Expressions of Interest

Electricité du Cambodge has received a financing from Agence Française de Développement ("AFD"), and intends to use part of the funds thereof for payments under the Grid Modernization on transmission and distribution system project, for support to digital change, organisation and audit services.

EDC intends to modernize its organization by further digitizing its processes while getting more resilient to cybersecurity threats.

To support this objective, EDC is recruiting a specialized consultant to provide services in the following three fields:

Support to the digital change

The Consultant will help EDC and its top management define a roadmap for digital change, identify processes to be digitized and implement the technical solutions. The Consultant will also help EDC management deploy the change in the organization and communicate on these as well as estimate and measure the added value of the proposed changes.

Audit of training organization and implementation of an e-Learning platform

The Consultant will conduct an audit on how training is organized within EDC, from identification of training requirements all the way to actual delivery of training, at the Institute of Electrical Science (IES) or elsewhere. The Consultant will propose organization changes were relevant.

The Consultant will specify and implement a new e-Learning platform to complement EDC's training capacity through IES.

Cybersecurity audit

The Consultant will conduct a full cyber-security audit of EDC's existing corporate IT systems and organization. The Consultant will identify weaknesses, propose mitigation measures and prepare their implementation.

The estimated budget to cover these consulting services is 450.000 EUR.

Eligibility criteria to AFD financing are specified in sub-clause 1.3 of the "Procurement Guidelines for AFD-Financed Contracts in Foreign Countries", available online on AFD's website: http://www.afd.fr.

The Applicant shall submit only one application, either in its own name or as a member of a Joint Venture (JV). If an Applicant (including any JV member) submits or participates in more than one application, those applications shall be all rejected. However, the same Subconsultant may participate in several applications.

If the Applicant is a JV, the expression of interest shall include:

a copy of the JV Agreement entered into by all members,

or

 a letter of intent to execute a JV Agreement, signed by all members together with a copy of the Agreement proposal,

In the absence of this document, the other members will be considered as Subconsultants.

Experiences and qualifications of Subconsultants are not taken into account in the evaluation of the applications.

Interested Applicants must provide information evidencing that they are qualified and experienced to perform those Services. For that purpose, documented evidence of recent and similar services shall be submitted.

Determination of the similarity of the experiences will be based on:

- The contracts size.
- The nature of the Services: digital change management, implementation of learning management systems or more specifically e-learning platforms, and cybersecurity audits.
- The technical area and expertise in digital change management, cybersecurity and learning management systems.
- The location in the region.

Applications will be evaluated and ranked using the scoring matrix provided in the appendix.

Among the submitted applications, Electricité du Cambodge will shortlist a maximum of 6 consultants, to whom the Request for Proposals to carry out the Services shall be sent.
